1619(b): What is it?
How to KEEP Medicaid and Earn Money.

Sections 1619(a) and 1619(b) of the Social Security Act let people who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and go to work keep their Medicaid coverage even when they are not getting an SSI check.

This is the money that comes on the 1st of each month in the mail or to your bank account.

1619(b) - well, what is it? Section 1619(a) and 1619(b) are within the Social Security Act. It lets people who receive Supplemental Security Income, which is called SSI, go to work and keep their Medicaid coverage even when they have earned enough income so that their SSI check is reduced to zero. This is the money that comes on the first day of the month and it's either going to come to your home or it's going to be direct deposited into your bank account, depending on how you've chosen to set that up with the Social Security Administration.

The 1619(b) Work Incentive training covers how individuals can be employed and still keep their Medicaid coverage. Jason's Outcome

Jason is no longer eligible for an SSI payment because his \$607.50 in countable income from Step 3 is more than his \$564.00 of SSI. However, under 1619(b) Jason could be eligible to keep his Medicaid.

Now Jason is no longer eligible for a cash payment due to SSI counting the \$607.50 in wages. This example shows earning income and using the work incentive under 1619(b) will give Jason a lot more money each month to live on than he would receive from SSI and he is still eligible to apply for Medicaid in Virginia.

Sealund used rapid prototyping in order to complete this program in 45 days. Sealund adhered to strict 508 compliance standards in the building of this course so that individuals with disabilities would be able to go through the training without difficulty. Sealund developed the 1619(b) training to be deployed via the Internet or CD-ROM.
